### Call for Student Posters – Due October 10, 2022

The key focus of this poster session is to showcase innovative student work around health information technology.

#### Eligibility

- Students must be registered and attending courses in an accredited academic undergraduate or graduate program currently or within the last 12 months prior to the application submission deadline. If accepted, they may be a program graduate at the time of presentation.
- Students must have a current Alabama, Louisiana, or Mississippi HIMSS Chapter membership by the submission deadline.

#### Guidelines

- A student must be the lead author. Co-authors may be students, faculty, or mentors.
- Only one submission per individual or group.
- At least one author of accepted posters must attend the conference on November 16-18, 2022 at the Hilton Capitol Center Hotel, 201 Lafayette St, Baton Rouge, LA 70801. (Registration fee will be waived for students (leading and co-authors) with accepted posters.
- This submission should include the following sections in a poster template (see links below for assistance with designing and ordering a poster): Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion.
- All posters should be printed landscape and be no larger than: 42" x 56". (Poster stands will be provided at the conference.)
- Please be sure to note in the poster how your work is **innovative** and **significant** to the field.
- The work does not need to be 100% complete by October 10. Preliminary results may be included in the application, and **all work must be completed** by November 1, 2022 and included in the final accepted poster submission.
- This form and poster submissions should be emailed to Dalton Pena at [depena@uab.edu](mailto:depena@uab.edu) with the subject as "2022 GC3 Student Poster Submission", no later than October 10, 2022 11:59 PM CST.
  - The email should include two PDF document attachments – the form and the poster:

- October 20, 2022: Notification of Acceptance/Rejection and Feedback
- October 25, 2022: Deadline for Authors to register for HIMSS GC3 2022 (Registration fee waived for accepted posters student authors. Code will be provided for registration.)
- November 1, 2022: Deadline for Authors to Submit Revised Final Poster
- November 1, 2022: Deadline for authors to book their hotel rooms. (Top 3 posters will receive stipends to be divided among student authors. 1<sup>st</sup> Place = \$599, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place = \$500, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place = \$400)
- November 16 or 17, 2022: Poster Presentation in Hilton Capitol Center Hotel, 201 Lafayette St, Baton Rouge, LA 70801 (in-person event)
